### **ESTHER'S BOOKSHELF**

THE RULE OF FOUR – SUSPENSEFUL FICTION – by Ian Caldwell and Dustin Thomason – 2004 "A tale of timeless intrigue, dazzling scholarship, and great imaginative power . . . story of a young man divided between the future's promise and the past's allure, guided only by friendship and love." "A mysterious coded manuscript, a violent Ivy League murder, and the secrets of a Renaissance prince collide in a labyrinth of betrayal, madness, and genius." Fascinating.

DVD – THE GIVER – Starring Jeff Bridges and Meryl Streep – Based on Lois Lowry's beloved young adult novel of the same name. Was awarded the 1994 Newberry Medal and has sold over 12 million copies worldwide. The community has dark and deadly secrets that are discovered by a young man who lives in a seemingly "ideal, somewhat colorless, existence of conformity and contentment." He realizes that with this new-found knowledge, "he must escape this world as a matter of life and death for himself and those he loves." A moving and thought-provoking film; follows the book closely and is approved by Ms. Lowry.

### CHURCH OF THE SMALL THINGS - BIOGRAPHY - by Melanie Shankle - 2017
