ESTHER'S BOOKSHELF CONTAINS GREAT DVDs AS WELL:

NF 2018 – <u>THE IMPOSSIBLE CLIMB: Alex Honnold, El Capitan, and the Climbing Life</u> by Mark Synnott. The gripping true story of the most perilous rock ascent of all time – a seamlessly fusing memoir, reporting, social history, climbing lore, technical expertise, and intimate glimpses of his tribe, Mark gives us an epic of life on the edge. "With the possible exception of the lunar landings, free soloing El Capitan may rank as one of the most audacious – and terrifying – things a human being has ever done. One of the most compelling accounts of a climb and the climbing ethos." – Sebastian Junger, *The Perfect Storm*.

Alex is the planet's foremost rock climber. To free solo means to climb without a rope for support in case one should fall. Even readers who have never set toe to rock are going to find themselves glued to this insanely brilliant account of extreme athletic ambition and endurance.

NF 2010 – <u>THE MURDER ROOM</u> by Michael Capuzzo. Greatest detectives around the world meet in a private club in Philadelphia to hunt down cold-case killers who thought they got away with it, accompanied by more than twenty photographs. (Heirs of Sherlock Holmes gather to solve the world's most perplexing cold cases.)

"Draws the reader into the secret investigations of the crime-fighting Vidocq Society named for flamboyant 19th Century Paris detective Eugene Francois Vidocq whose real-life adventures inspired the creation of the detective novel."

A cast of serial killers and other human monsters who had long outsmarted the police in some of the most chilling cases in the world, a true tale of evil as old as the Bible. A descent into the lowest regions of hell and a climb to the highest redemption.

DVD 2004 – <u>TOUCHING THE VOID</u> – Joe Simpson, 24; Simon Yates, 21. Riveting true story. "Astonishing journey" – "Absolutely incredible" – "Extraordinary and inspiring." Involves climbing Suila Grande in Peru, 21,000 foot high mountain, never before conquered. Enroute on the descent Joe shatters his leg in an awful fall – a MUST-SEE film!

F 2018 – <u>A THOUSAND DOORS</u> – Edited by J. T. Ellison. The imaginary life of 44-year old Mia Jensen – told in short stories, uniquely each one an alternate life. Well-written – examines how our smallest decisions can create lasting effects and allows the thought – can we actually change our lives?
